Who Should Attend?

- Pre-seed and seed-stage firms, including faculty-driven start-up companies
- University spin-outs and incubator companies working to commercialize life science technologies

What is the Format?

- BioStrategy Sessions are typically two-hour meetings that allow participants to deliver a 15-20 minute presentation about their business opportunity
- Presentations are followed by an intense strategic discussion meant to address critical issues, highlight potential weaknesses and provide actionable guidance
