CAN YOU BUILD A STARTUP AROUND YOUR TECHNOLOGY?

WHAT YOU'LL GET FROM THE PROGRAM:

- An experiential learning opportunity to help you and your team determine the commercial readiness of your technology
- The basis for a go/no go decision on commercial viability
- A prospective transition plan to move the technology forward to market if you decide to do so
- Possible nomination to the NSF I-Corps Teams National Program that offers a \$50,000 grant

The I-Corps team will deliver the Lean Launchpad program live over a two week span allowing you to complete assignments between the three in-person workshops. You will be able to record what you have learned on the online platform Launchpad on GLIDR, and in visual tools that will focus your development of a business model.

NSF I-Corps has trained more than 3,745 individuals in 1,315 teams from 271 institutions that have created 644 companies and gotten \$301M in funding.
